

# REHABILITATION

The process of recovering from an injury or illness can sometimes be intimidating. The CC Young Rehabilitation team is with you in every step of your recovery, beginning with building treatment plans to guide you in all phases of healing, from initial diagnosis through the restorative and preventive stages of post-recovery.

Our Director of Rehabilitation answers a few questions about rehab at CC Young:

**Q:** What is the average time frame a patient attends rehabilitation?

A: Floors 7 and 8 of The Vista are our inpatient rehabilitation floors. These residents typically stay for 21 days. Outpatient varies based upon the therapy needed, but on average we see most patients for 4-6 weeks.

**Q:** What do you think is the most important thing a patient can do to ensure success?

**A:** To be successful, the key is to follow the home exercise program that the therapist sets. This helps a patient progress while in therapy and then maintain what they have achieved after therapy.

**Q:** Can you tell us what differentiates CC Young rehab from other rehab facilities?

**A:** Most other rehab facilities do not have the resources and continuum of care that we have at CC Young. A patient can be admitted to our rehab facility with an injury or ailment that requires our intervention. They can stay for a few weeks on our rehab floors to get strong enough to return home. Through our Community Service Program we can transition patients to our Home Health team to work with the patient in their own environment and ensure they are functioning safely. Once this is established the patient can transition to our outpatient rehab and aquatic center to maximize their recovery from the injury. Other facilities may offer some of these options but rarely can they match our overall comprehensive care.

# HOSPICE

CC Young Hospice care focuses on the quality of life for patients who are experiencing an advanced, terminal illness. Hospice provides compassionate, loving care from a team of professionals working together to manage symptoms for patients so they may live as fully and comfortably as possible. Hospice is not intended to hasten or postpone death, but manages symptoms of the disease so the end of life is spent with dignity and quality, surrounded by love and family. The patient and family are the center of care. They make the decisions to guide their own path.

Palliative care is offered in hospice care, but it also can be given separately from hospice. Palliative care is sometimes called supportive care, symptom management, pain control, or comfort care. Most often it is used for those who are still pursuing aggressive and curative treatment, but have bothersome symptoms that require expert management.



Our Hospice care is available wherever a person calls home – on or off campus. It is a benefit covered 100% by Medicare and Medicaid and includes the services listed here. For more information, please contact us by calling **214-841-2825.**

CC Young has assembled an expert interdisciplinary team to care for patients whose symptoms can no longer be managed at home, have medically complex needs, or have experienced a sudden decline in condition and need round-the-clock skilled nursing care. Our GIP unit will help get symptoms under control to experience a better quality of life at the end of life.


